Option 1: Crafter can have one web page consisting of up to 15 photos (TPV can scan any photos or use jpg images). All information regarding the craft items must be typed up by the crafter. Please include shipping costs. You can sell as many items as you want. Your profit is your own!!! TPV only collects the \$10.00 for DLF. TPV is not responsible for unpaid craft items or un-received items; it is up to the seller and buyer to settle these matters. We will make this note posted on the pages. We suggest if you have used ebay or yahoo auctions to list your username so people can see positive feedback, making them more likely to purchase. When you sell out of something PLEASE INFORM us, so we can quickly remove the item(s). *Last day to receive sign-ups is October 29th, either by mail or by email.*

Option 2: Donated items need (pretty please) to be in our hands by November 9th, in order to sell during November's fair. We will take anything that is of good quality and from the heart ☺. If items are not sold, we will offer them back to the original crafter, or with their permission sell them on ebay to raise funds. TPV will set the price for each donated item.
